As determined by our Executive Committee, we are again requiring our dinner attendees to RSVP, either by the lodge app or by calling the assistant Secretary at 510-758-7031. Please reserve as early as possible to ensure we have the correct number of meals prepared. If you RSVP but later cannot attend, please cancel your reservation.

We are also phasing in an increase in the cost of dinners. We are NOT having a dinner prior to the August 3 Stated Meeting. Our September 7 dinner will cost \$5.00, and a RSVP is REQUIRED. The October 3 dinner cost will be \$10.00 for the member, \$7.50 for the spouse/partner, member's children will be no charge, as well as Widows. The October dinner will be meatloaf and mashed potatoes with all the trimmings. The cost of dinners in later months will reflect the actual caterer's "permeal" price, including the cost of covid-19 required cleaning protocols and increase in the wholesale cost of food.

Over the last several years, the increasing costs of food and the lack of sufficient RSVP's has resulted in a food subsidy of about 75 percent. This impacts the needed funding away from other budgeted programs, including funding our training and events

COVID 19 CHANGES EFFECTIVE July 17, 2021 TO ALL TENANTS: FACE MASK/COVERING CHANGE:

On Friday July 16, 2021, the seven bay area counties agreed to recommend the wearing of face masks/covers whenever indoors regardless of vaccination status effective Midnight July 17, 2021. Effective immediately, the Richmond Masonic Hall Association (MHAR) requires all tenants and guests wear a face mask/cover within its facilities until further notice.

COVID 19 SANITIZING FEE: \$135 Front Hall Area. \$65 Back Hall Area. This fee is separate from your normal cleaning fee. Effective July 17, 2021 a charge will be applied to each rental event to pay for the labor and material costs to apply CDC COVID19 compliant sanitizer.
