172nd Annual Communication

Join your fellow California Masons to mark this most unforgettable year, and help us push the fraternity into the future. Annual Communication is a weekend of important business and serious fun, where members make connections to brothers from around the state and gain a new perspective on what we are capable of achieving, together again.

Proof of vaccination will be required to attend Annual Communication and its events. Negative COVID-19 tests will not be accepted. Please see details of these COVID-19 protocols, below.

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

There will be new protocols in place to comply with San Francisco's COVID-19 safety requirements.

These protocols are:

 All attendees, staff, and exhibitors over the age of 12 will be required to show proof of full vaccination before entering the California Masonic Memorial Temple, and at the Grand Master's Banquet and Gala, the Spouses and Partners, and all other dinners and events that occur inside. Full vaccination means that the final dose (or single dose, in the case of Johnson & Johnson) of the vaccine was administered by September 24, 2021, which is two weeks prior to the event.

- Masks will be required indoors at all times, unless actively eating or drinking.
- Children over the age of 12 are required to be vaccinated. Children over the age of 2 are required to wear masks indoors.
- Negative COVID-19 tests are not sufficient to enter the California Masonic Memorial Temple, or attend an event.
- Proof of vaccination can be digital. You can show a
 picture of your vaccination card and photo ID, use
 a digital COVID-19 vaccine record issued by the
 State of California, or an approved private app to
 verify vaccination status.

Brethren:

The attached notice is being sent to all tenants informing them that effective September 22, 2021 proof of COVID19 vaccination or a negative COVID19 Test certificate prior to entering our facilities. This action is taken in response to the health order approved by the Contra Costa County Department of Public Health (CCCDPH) issued on Tuesday, September 14, 2021 and is effective September 22, 2021 throughout Contra Costa County. As with the *mask* restriction, the *proof of vaccination/test* restriction will remain in-effective until further notice.

The following is the announcement by CCCDPH...

"Contra Costa County issued a health order Tuesday requiring patrons to prove they are fully vaccinated against COVID-19 before entering businesses where they remove their masks to eat or drink or tend to breathe heavily from exercising.

The new health order will take effect Sept. 22. Among the businesses that fall under the vaccine mandate are restaurants, bars and entertainment venues, as well as gyms and fitness facilities such as yoga and dance studios. Anyone age 12 and older who enters those businesses will need to show proof of full vaccination, including a photo ID and either a vaccination record card or photos of those cards. Without such proof, they must present a negative COVID-19 test result from the past three days.

Workers at those businesses also must show proof of full vaccination by Nov. 1 or test weekly for COVID-19. Contra Costa will join San Francisco and Berkeley in demanding the so-called "vaccine passports."

The key wording that would cause the MHAR to be included in the new order is: "where they remove their masks to eat or drink or tend to breathe heavily from exercising."
