On activities conducted, aside from the regular MM meetings, MHAR Meetings and DOSI, there were 14 Degree Conferrals, 4 Celebration of Life, 3 Lodge Work Parties, 5 Dinner Dances, 4 GRIP Feeding Programs, and 1 each of Inter Lodge Picnic, Hiram Award, El Sobrante Stroll & Kids Workshop.

After his report, WM Dan Laynes awarded Certificate of Appreciation to the Lodge Officers and their wives for their active participation and unwavering support to the different Lodge activities; to Bro Vernon Morales and Bro Zhengzhe Zhang for donating their time doing maintenance work in the Lodge; to WB Edgar & Sis Cora De Castro for ensuring that the Lodge properties are well maintained and profitable; and to Bro Jing & Sis Sally Gavieres for their unwavering support and 100% attendance in the different Lodge activities.
