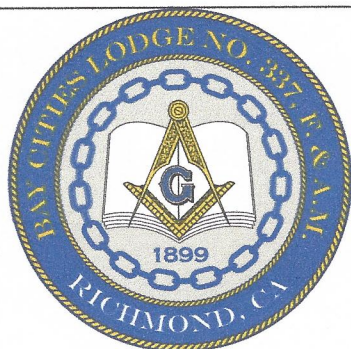

Brethren,

During this month of June, we reflect upon the struggle of Filipino people to free themselves from the yoke of colonization. We remember not only a nation's struggle for freedom, but also the important role Freemasonry played in shaping the ideals behind that struggle.

Many of the heroes of Philippine independence, including José Rizal, Marcelo del Pilar and Andrés Bonifacio, were Masons. At a time when society was divided by class and colonial rule, Masonry taught men to meet upon the level and judge one another by character rather than status.

The lessons of Philippine independence remind us that freedom requires more than patriotism. It requires truth, responsibility, and moral courage. And perhaps the greatest example Masonry can offer society today is this: that men with different beliefs can still meet together in peace and call each other Brother. May we continue to preserve liberty not only through words, but through the way we live and treat one another.
